NEW! The Introductory Pathway is a one-year program designed to allow students to explore a large number of health care careers and prepare for LNA licensure* with the potential to earn up to 3 college credits. Students in this pathway are likely to seek employment coming out of high school and may pursue further education with the benefit of tuition reimbursement through their employer.

The Advanced (College-Preparatory) Pathway includes an intensive, two-year science curriculum augmented with hands-on labs, which reinforce the subject matter learned in the classroom. Students in this program have the potential to earn up to 17 college credits. Students in this pathway are likely to pursue a college degree directly after high school.
